

## Installing DDD on a mac (written by Diego Gutierrez Feb 2012)

Go to <http://www.macports.org/> click on installing MacPorts on the side menu

Select the dmg file for your OS (they have them listed as links by the name of the release i.e: 10.7 is Lion ... etc)

Download the dmg file and then double click to mount it

Double click on the .pkg file that is in the dmg and MacPorts will begin installing ... just follow the prompts until the installer is finished

Once it is installed open a terminal and then to install DDD type *sudo port install ddd* (note: you need to know the root password to install the program)

Wait until the install is done, this will take quite a while since it needs to download and install all the dependencies

Once the install is done you can run ddd by typing *ddd <program name>* (note: ddd is an X11 application so it will open an X11 app in your dock but ddd itself won't show up in the dock)

MacPorts also has many other programs that are easy to install on Linux, you can search for an application by typing *port* this will bring up the interactive mode then you type *search <program name>* to search for an application
